

What is a Responsible Behaviour Plan?

Currajong State School is committed to enhancing the learning of our students through our five core values.

We seek to provide a safe, supportive and predictable environment that is conducive to effective learning. As a school community, we believe that students learn and develop best in an atmosphere of care and kindness, underpinned by reasonable, consistent discipline. An engaging curriculum, dedicated, highly organised teachers and a supportive school community, creates a powerful influence on the development of our children.

Currajong State School's *Responsible Behaviour Plan for students* emphasises the provision of a consistent school environment.

Through our school plan, shared expectations for student behaviour are explicit. The plan assists Currajong State School to create and maintain a positive and productive learning and teaching environment. This ensures all school community members have clear and consistent expectations and understandings of their role in the educational process. The matrix on the following page outlines these expectations

We believe that discipline is a function of care and that the application of consequences for inappropriate behaviour is the result of caring about a child's development and about the safety and well-being of all children in the school for whom we are responsible.

Positive Behaviour Responses

Cool School Day

Once a term students who have reached a predetermined behaviour goal are rewarded with a Cool School Day celebration.

Good Ones

Good Ones are handed out by all staff members to students showing great Currajong State School citizenship and following the school core values.

Positive Behaviour Cards

Each week on parade, classes are recognised for their efforts and awarded a healthy food platter to share.

Currajong Care Bear

The Care Bear is awarded each week to the class deemed by administration staff to have used the exemplary manners and have shown role model skills to their peers.

Litter Legends Award

This trophy is awarded weekly to the year level which has shown the most pride in their respective area by keeping it safe and clear of rubbish.

Student of the Week

Each week on Parade students are recognised for their efforts and awarded student of the week awards.

Inappropriate Behaviour Responses

Removal from an activity or event for a specified period of time, individual meeting with the student, loss of privilege, alternate lunchtime activities, apology, restitution, detention, parent contact, suspension and or exclusion from school.
